General Information

- 1 The application form is common for all courses i.e.** Master of Occupational Therapy, Diploma in Rehabilitation (Occupational Therapy), Master of Physiotherapy and Diploma in Rehabilitation (Physiotherapy). Candidates are supposed to tick mark in the appropriate box while filing up the Application Form.
- 2 Seats will be allotted as per merit, according to results of Entrance Examination.**
- 3 Prospectus/Application form fee and Processing fees:**
(Demand Draft/ Pay Order should be Drawn in favour of 'Director, AIIPMR' Payable at Mumbai, from any Nationalized Bank)
 - 3.1 Prospectus & Application form fee is Rs. 150/-**, in the form of Demand Draft / Pay order to be Drawn in favour of '**Director, AIIPMR**' Payable at Mumbai. **This fee needs to be paid when the candidate obtains the form in person or by post.**
 - 3.2 Processing fee is Rs.500/- for each course** in the form of Demand Draft/ Pay order to be Drawn in favour of '**Director, AIIPMR**' Payable at Mumbai, **along with application form.**
 - 3.3** For SC/ST Candidates Processing fee relaxed to Rs. 400/-.
 - 3.4** In case if candidate wants to apply for two courses, total amount to be paid in the form of demand draft/ Pay order will be for General category candidates (Rs. 500 + Rs. 500 + Rs. 150)= Rs. 1150/- & for SC/ST category candidates (Rs. 400 + Rs. 400 + Rs. 150)= Rs. 950/-.
 - 3.5 Combined Demand Draft can be accepted for Processing fee + Application form fee from candidates who are applying online and who are downloading the application forms from the website (Rs. 500/400 + Rs.150/-= Rs. 650/- or Rs. 550/-).**
 - 3.6** Payment in any other form will be rejected. The processing fee /Application form fee is non- refundable and non-transferable under any circumstance.

4 A) PROCEDURE TO APPLY ONLINE:

- i)** Candidate can apply online, then download the confirmation page, paste a photo on it (attested by Principal / Head of the Institutions/ Gazetted Officer) and send it with extra photograph, self attested at the back, along with demand draft (DD) and attested copies of mandatory certificates/Documents.
- ii)** On successful application the system will show the candidate's status as "applied for" but the status would change to "successfully applied" only when the confirmation page is received along with D.D. by the Institute.

4 B) PROCEDURES TO APPLY OFFLINE:

- ii) By Registered post:** A self addressed envelope of size 30cms. x 25 cms (A4 size) affixing postage stamp of **Rs. 60/-** Superscribed as "**Application for(name of the course) course 2011**" should be sent by speed post to the Institute along with Application form fee/Prospectus fee; in the form of a Demand Draft/ pay order of Rs.150/- drawn in favour of the Director AIIPMR payable at Mumbai.



- iii) **By Downloading** from Institute website www.aiipmr.gov.in/ www.aiipmronline.nic.in. Duly filled in forms can be forwarded to Institute; along with Processing fees & Application form fee/Prospectus fee in the form of Demand draft/ pay order drawn in favor of 'Director – AIIPMR', payable at Mumbai and attested photocopies of Mandatory certificates by post to the institute.

9 Admit Card will be generated only for eligible candidates.

- iii) **In case** of delay, or non receipt of Admit Card, candidates can collect the Duplicate Admit Card from Academic Section of this Institute, on the day of Entrance Test on producing copy of Demand Draft and confirmation page of online application form with valid proof of posting.

10.5 **Section - I is compulsory for all candidates and** will cover **questions on** basic medical subjects taught at undergraduate level i.e. BTh/ BPTTh.

Section – II will be answered by those candidates who have applied for MTh/DR(OT) course.

Section – III will be answered by those candidates who have applied for MPTTh/ DR(PT) course.

10.6 Syllabus for all three sections will be based on undergraduate level i.e. BTh/ BPTTh syllabus of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS), Nashik. **For detailed syllabus of BTh/ BPTTh log on to MUHS website www.muhsnashik.com.**

10.7 Mobile phone ,calculators and any electronic devices will not be permitted in Exam Hall.

10.8 **Declaration of list of selected candidates will be on Institute notice board and Website: as per schedule on Annexure- i**

10.9 There will be no **rechecking /re-evaluation** for the Entrance Test answer sheets. However candidate can apply for verification of marks by giving an application on plain paper, within **four days** of declaration of Entrance Test results, alongwith processing fee of **500/-** in the form of Demand Draft to be Drawn in favour of '**Director, AIIPMR**' Payable at Mumbai.

List of selected candidates will be displayed on the website and will be intimated by speed post. 12 Cancellation of admission:

In case a student cancels his / her admission before the cutoff date, fifty percent fees paid will be forfeited.

In case the admission is cancelled after the cutoff date; full amount of fees paid will be forfeited.

12.1 Cutoff date for admission is declared by University.

13 Hostel:

13.1 The Institute has limited hostel facility, and allotment will be done by the Hostel Committee, as per laid down criteria. Due to space constraints, the students will have to be prepared for dormitory type accommodation. It is not insisted upon by the Institute authorities for hostel stay, and students are at liberty to make their own arrangement.

14 Conduct & Discipline:

14.1 Failure of the candidate in making full and correct statements in the application form and/or suppression of any information would lead to disqualification of the candidate for the course.

14.2 Adopting any unfair means or engaging in malpractice in the examination hall is strictly prohibited.

14.3 Ragging in any form is prohibited and is a punishable offence as per Honorable Supreme Court directives no. CIVIL APPEAL NO. 887 OF 2009. **The Institute authority will rusticate the student at once if found involved in ragging.**

14.4 In any issue other than dealt with above, the decision of Institute Authority will be final.

14.5 Any disputes arising out of admission process will be under legal jurisdiction of Mumbai High Court.



Information for Master of Physiotherapy (MPTh)/ Master of Occupational Therapy (MOTh)

15 Eligibility:

- 15.1 The course is open to Physiotherapists/ Occupational Therapists holding Bachelors Degree in Physiotherapy/ Occupational Therapy respectively, from a recognized University, with completion of Six months compulsory internship.
- 15.2 Date of completion of Internship: **as per Annexure - i**
- 15.3 The candidate must be Indian National.
- 15.4 Students who have done Bachelors degree from Agricultural University and Distance Education are not eligible as per DMER/ MUHS guidelines.
- 15.5 **Duration** : Three academic years.
Candidates are expected to engage in entire patient management on inpatient and outpatient basis.
- 15.6 **University Affiliation** : Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik. (MUHS, Nashik)
- 15.7 **Eligibility of the candidates admitted, is granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and Institute takes no responsibility for the same. It is not assured by the Institute at the time of admission that University will grant eligibility to the candidate.**
- 15.8 **Date of commencement of academic session:** As per MUHS guidelines

***As per Guidelines of S.N.D.T. Women's University (Ref. No. Aff.Gen-1/AIIPMR/2009-10/1805. Dated 15/2/2010) only girls can be admitted to the above course.**

19.2 The course is open for Occupational Therapists/ Physiotherapists holding Bachelors Degree in Occupational Therapy / Physiotherapy respectively from a recognised University with Six months compulsory internship.

19.3 **Eligibility of the candidates admitted is granted by S.N.D.T. Women's University, Mumbai and Institute takes no responsibility for the same. It is not assured by the Institute at the time of admission that University will grant eligibility to the candidate.**

- 24.3 A candidate will have to submit three typed and bound copies of the dissertation work carried out under the departmental guide recognized by the University, two weeks in advance of the date of commencement of final examination declared by the University. 25. Course duration is of one year and candidates are expected to engage in entire patient management on inpatient and outpatient basis.
